On March 5, 2025, millions of Christians worldwide will celebrate Ash Wednesday and the Imposition of the Ashes. Ash Wednesday begins the liturgical season known as Lent, a period of 40 days where Christians, symbolically, journey with Christ to the Cross. During Lent, the faithful engage in prayer, fasting and regret for their sins. Lent is a time of deep reflection to ponder ourselves, our lives as well as our sense of meaning or purpose. The ashes remind us of our place in the world. The refrain that is repeated on Ash Wednesday as the ashes are imposed is, "Remember, dust thou art and unto dust thou shalt return."
