Notes:

1) **Vacation Time:** There will be 3-4 weeks of vacation per PGY year. Vacation should be taken during elective or subspecialty rotations and not more than 2 weeks at a time. Vacation will not be considered during ICU and ER rotations, continuity clinic weeks, and night float rotations. Vacation for a maximum of 1 week will be considered during wards only if it is an emergency or non-emergency situations like birth of a child or getting married.

2) **Selectives:** **Requirements (PGY2-3):** Residents should prioritize completion of the required Internal Medicine subspecialty elective experiences (Selectives) before scheduling additional elective rotations. Minimum Required Exposure (2 weeks each)for PGY2-3: Pulmonary Medicine, Rheumatology, Allergy & Immunology, Women's Health (Pending) and Geriatrics (Pending).

3) **Electives offered:** Cardiology, Hematology- Oncology, Nephrology, Gastroenterology, Infectious Diseases, Endocrinology, Pulmonary Disease, Rheumatology, and Allergy & Immunology.

Electives Pending: Women's Health ,Geriatrics ,Palliative Care,Research & Quality Improvement Patient Safety (QIPS) x1month minimum, Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine(OMM), and Anesthesiology.

4) **Residents will have the opportunity for experience in non-internal medicine sub-specialties.**
